

Risks & Complications discussed with patient Total Knee Replacement

- Deep Infection: <1%; could require open washout (<1/250) or even removal of implant as 2-stage procedure (<1/500). *Mitigated* by iv ABs
- □ **DVT/PE**: 5%/1%. *Mitigated* by clexane injections in hospital and aspirin for 4w after discharge
- □ **Vascular injury**: <1/500; could result in compartment syndrome or require arterial repair.
- □ NB: pain, stiffness, swelling and lateral knee numbness normal up to 12months postop; early thigh pain common from tourniquet
